XXV Congress of the World Veterinary Association (WVA) and XX Congress of the World Small Animal Veterinary Association (WSAVA) will be jointly held at the same place in the same period. Therefore, this Congress will truly be a World Veterinary Congress covering all aspects of veterinary medicine and veterinary science.

Plenary Sessions

- (2) Environmental issues and veterinary science
- (3) Veterinary ethics in animal welfare
- (4) Animal health and food sanitation in the wake of increased intenational trade

<u>Symposia</u>

Up to 18 symposia will be held during the 1995 WVC. Each symposium should be approximately three hours long. Most symposia will be provided with interpretation in six official languages.

WSAVA Program

A unique WSAVA program of special invitation lectures, prize lectures, lectures on the latest in science and technology and more is planned.

Free Communication Sessions

Total hours allocated for the sessions are approximately 260 hours. Papers for free communications should be submitted in English. Presentations should be done either in English or Japanese, and should not exceed 20 minutes including discussions.

Video Presentation

A program of video presentations will be organised to introduce the newest technology, surgical techniques, clinical data, equipment etc. in the video session hall, the video library hall and elsewhere.

Commercial Exhibitions

Commercial exhibitions will be held in a exhibition hall of 10,000 square metres at the Congress site. These will be jointly organised by the WVA and the WSAVA.

Social Programme

There will be a banquet, special programmes for auxiliary staff, a concert, and nightly events in addition to sight-seeing tours during and after the Congress.
