at Lillehammer, Norway*

Bovine virus diarrhoea is a common infectious disease in cattle in almost every country in the world. The disease causes great economic losses every year. Considerable efforts are needed to reduce these losses.

The Scandinavian countries have started control programmes with the ambitious goal to eradicate the disease from our cattle population.

This conference will focus on control and possible eradication of the disease and related aspects of the BVD problem.

Topics to be discussed:

- diagnosis, epidemiology
- new aspects of acute infection with BVDV
- border disease and BVD in wild ruminants
- influence on general health and fertility - economical importance
- immunology, vaccination
- control- and eradication programmes

The symposium will bring together workers from veterinary and microbiological laboratories, universities and veterinary faculties, regulatory authorities and agricultural organizations.

The symposium will include presentations by invited international experts, oral presentations and posters as well as general discussions.
